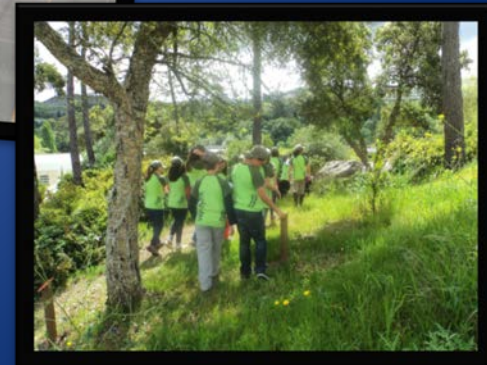

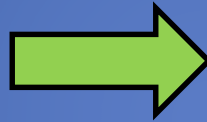
Our School Cluster

A tramline connects Sintra and Praia das Maças.

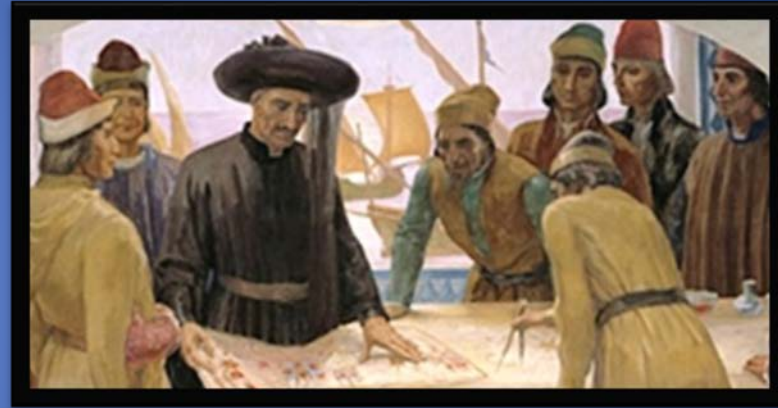
